

Professor Karl Schaller is Chairman of the Department of Neurosurgery at the Geneva University Medical Center and Faculty of Medicine at the University of Geneva since 2007. His expertise lies predominantly in dealing with neurovascular surgery, epilepsy, brain tumors and in image-co-registration for surgical navigation. Over a 25 year illustrious career he has over 200 publications in medical and scientific journals to his credit and has performed app. 5000 cranial and spinal surgeries.



Professor Schaller is the recipient of funding from DFG, the German research and science foundation and SNSF, the Swiss agency promoting scientific research. He receives funding for the development of intra-operative imaging technology, for the co-registration of complementary imaging modalities, and for clinical neurovascular research.

Professor Schaller is the co-founder of The Geneva Institute, a premier surgical training and research institute, president of the Swiss Society of Neurosurgery, and chair of the training committee of the EANS. He serves on the editorial and/or advisory boards of numerous publications including Acta Neurochirurgica, Neurosurgical Focus, Neurosurgery and World Neurosurgery.
